

SFMOMA ANNOUNCES FREE DAY FOR THE COMMUNITY ON SUNDAY, DECEMBER 8

Lively Array of Programming Offered Including a Small Press Book Bazaar, Screenings of Nicole Miller's To the Stars and Story Time



WHAT:

The San Francisco Museum of Modern Art (SFMOMA) opens to the public for free on Sunday, December 8, 2019. All are welcome to choose from an array of activities for all ages, including exhibition tours, an interactive Lidar experience presented by Cruise, story time with San Francisco Public Library librarians, a Small Press Book Bazaar in the Gina and Stuart Peterson White Box and public screenings of conceptual artist Nicole Miller's multi-sensory work *To the Stars* in the Phyllis Wattis Theater. Visitors will experience seven floors of contemporary and modern art while enjoying current exhibitions on view, including *Far Out: Suits, Habs, and Labs for Outer Space; 2019 SECA Art Award;* and *SOFT POWER*, among others. Visitors are also encouraged to drop in to the Roberts Family Gallery to witness artist JR's animated digital mural, *The Chronicles of San Francisco*, celebrating the people and stories of San Francisco.

Admission on this day is free for up to two adults per reservation (visitors 18 and younger are always free at SFMOMA). All reservations for Free Day will be entered to win a one-year museum

membership. To reserve a ticket for Free Day, visit <u>SFMOMA.org/FreeDay</u>. Free Day activities will conclude at 4:30 p.m., while the galleries will remain open until the museum closes at 5 p.m.
