ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY

These records were assembled from 1962 through 1964 by volunteers from the Junior League helping to conduct a complete inventory of the permanent collection by, in part, gathering all records that made reference to accessioned works. Volunteers were instructed to remove all “pertinent material” from the museum’s administrative files, underline the name of the most relevant artist in red pencil, and file the individual pages alphabetically in “bins.” Examples of pertinent material include records related to the purchase or gift of artworks, exhibitions held at the museum, loans of artworks by or through the museum, insurance, reproduction requests, and scholarly opinions of artworks.

The files were organized alphabetically by the last name of the relevant artist or by subject, depending on their contents. Many of the folders were reused from museum staff files and have several crossed-out titles. The majority of the folders contain between one and five sheets of paper and may not relate directly to the artist under which they are filed.

Once the administrative files had been culled, they were reviewed again by curators John Humphrey and/or Anneliese Hoyer to remove further correspondence for the “archives.” It is unclear where these removed records are now, but many files are marked with some variation of the phrase “Checked for correspondence re Primary Collection.” Presumably the “archives” and the “Primary Collection” are the same. Occasional correspondence with artists, underlined in red pencil, was found throughout the early administrative records, though it is unclear whether it was actually refiled with the original records after being removed by the volunteers.

Arrangement Note

The original order within the folders has been maintained.

Processing Note

The records are fully processed. They were rehoused in acid-free paper folders, paper clips and straight pins were removed, and newsprint and other corrosive materials were interleaved with acid-free paper.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Permanent Collection Inventory Project of the Junior League, 1934–1964

The materials in these files date primarily from 1935 through 1955, though some documents are dated as early as 1934 or as late as 1964.

The Miscellaneous files include a range of materials about artists or subjects generally beginning with the same letter of the alphabet. The divisions, however, are not reliable, as, for instance, correspondence with Maynard Dixon can be found in C Miscellaneous. In addition, correspondence with artists with dedicated files may sometimes be found in Miscellaneous files.

Some materials that may have originally been housed together in administrative records were separated and dispersed, making them nearly impossible to understand as a group or based on their original context. In organizing one of the first exhibitions shown at the museum, the 1934 Carnegie International, the museum sent forms to each artist who exhibited in the original show to invite them to participate in the San Francisco exhibition. Dozens of forms completed by the artists are dispersed throughout these files alphabetically by artist name. Correspondence with and announcements from the Western Association of Art Museum Directors about circulating exhibitions and individual works are filed with the first artist listed, though contents may relate to multiple exhibitions and works.

When more than one artist is referenced in any other letter, exhibition inventory, or register of artists, the document is generally filed with the artist whose name comes first alphabetically. In addition, if a letter written to one artist names another artist, the document was filed under the named artist rather than the recipient.

Below is a list of notable or unexpected items in files, as well as other explanatory information.

- Permanent Collection Information—Includes various lists of works in the permanent collection. Most are undated, and many describe aspects of the collection by genre (e.g., portraits), collection (e.g., William Gerstle Collection), or medium (e.g., oil).
- A–Z Miscellaneous—Compiled from loose, unfiled correspondence found in the box where the records were originally housed.
- A Miscellaneous—Includes a 1946 letter to Peggy Guggenheim/Art of This Century about the 1946 Mark Rothko exhibition.
- Jean Abel—Contains only the checklist for the Twelfth Annual Exhibition of the San Francisco Society of Women Artists (1937), where Abel is listed first.
- Acuna—Materials related to the artist are included both in this file and in A Miscellaneous.
- Inés Amor—Amor was the director of the Galería de Arte Mexicano, Mexico City. This file contains one sheet of correspondence; additional correspondence from her about a Raúl Anguiano drawing can be found in the Anguiano folder.
- M. Baxte—Contains a 1955 acquisitions list.
- Georges Braque—Primarily contains letters from Grace McCann Morley in defense of the Carnegie Prize for Braque's *The Yellow Cloth*.
- Paul Cezanne—This file is especially thick and primarily contains correspondence from 1935 through 1939. In particular, it includes a great deal of general museum correspondence from 1937, when the museum mounted a large Cézanne exhibition. Unrelated letters mention the mailing of an exhibition catalogue, that the show was in the museum, and the show's high attendance.
- Chinese—Primarily contains exhibition records from the 1935–1936 Imperial Robes/Colby exhibition and the 1937 *Chinese Tomb Statuettes* show.
- Disney—Primarily related to the 1938 Disney exhibition.
- E Miscellaneous—Includes the topic "Exhibition," meaning any exhibition.

- F Miscellaneous—Includes the topic “Furniture.”
- Paul Gauguin—Primarily related to the 1936 Gauguin exhibition.
- Gerstle Collection—William Gerstle was an artist, collector, and museum board member. This file includes letters to artists notifying them that Gerstle had bought their work.
- L Miscellaneous—Contains a 1937 list of the Harriet Lane Levy Collection.
- Some dedicated artist files that start with *L* contain correspondence related to additional artists. For example, the Linares file contains correspondence related to Jacques Lipchitz and other artists with names that begin with *L*.
- John Lewis—Contains a list of acquisitions from 1936–1937.
- Henri Matisse—Contains some correspondence with Pierre Matisse regarding loans from the Pierre Matisse Gallery, New York.
- Rousseau—Primarily contains correspondence about the Phelan Estate.
- S Miscellaneous—Includes documents related to the San Diego Fine Arts Gallery, the San Francisco Society of Women Artists, Surrealism, screenprints, stencil prints (list of David Park stencil prints), sculptors, Maurice Sterne, and more.
- V Miscellaneous—Includes some W Miscellaneous.
- XYZ Miscellaneous—Includes some W Miscellaneous.
